- Existing fence to be removed and area to be planted
  - Proposed recycled timber seating, picnic and bbq area with inlet view
  - Proposed nature play area
  - Existing section of path to be removed (cultural monitor to be present for all infrastructure removals)
  - Existing diamond surfaces to be upgraded to sand carpet (outfield) and 3G artificial grass (infield).
  - Proposed viewing mounds (imported fill) for spectator seating
  - Two proposed softball warm up cages (24m x 5m)
  - Proposed softball diamonds lighting poles as per NCCA Baseball lighting standards and upgrade of softball backstop fencing, as part of the Auckland Softball Facility Plan March 2017.
  - Proposed one sided carpark with 12 vehicle capacity
  - Proposed native specimen trees (Pohutukawa Maori Princess)
  - Existing entrance to be retained and linked to proposed path network
  - All junior diamond surfaces to be upgraded to hybrid surfaces
  - Existing building to be removed and new building erected to accommodate clubrooms, storage, 4 changing rooms, 1 refs room and public toilets. All buildings will be equipped with rain water harvesting systems to be used for toilets.
  - Proposed 1.8m wide path through the middle of the park to provide linkage between the main road and coastal path, along existing "desire line".
  - Existing coastal path widened to 2.5m
  - Proposed fitness equipment spread throughout path to promote health and regular use paths
  - Proposed path connecting existing road footpath, building and coastal path.
  - Fence and hedge to be removed and replaced with bollards and specimen trees to provide visual permeability, physical access and improve safety through passive surveillance.
  - Existing scouts hall/Counties Manukau Softball Club building to be removed.
  - Proposed path improving link between Wood Street and coastal path
  - Existing embankment to be retained treatment to address erosion of existing path
  - Proposed footpath to connect Wharf Street, carpark and proposed multipurpose building
  - Existing footpath extended to connect road footpath to park pedestrian network
  - Public toilets to be built next to the existing clubrooms to promote accessibility
  - Recycled timber spectator seating to view league and softball games
  - Existing club rooms owned by league club to be leased to the community when multipurpose club building (#13) is built
  - Storm water outlets to be treated through rain gardens.
  - Cultural signage or pou along path
