1. Introduction

The purpose of this report is to provide an assessment and recommendation in relation to designations, modifications and new designations classified by the Independent Hearings Panel as moderately complex. This classification will generally apply where there is a:

- rollover of a designation with no modifications and a submission lodged by third party;
- ii. modification to a designation that will result in more than minor effects and with or without submissions;
- iii. notice of requirement for a new designation for existing works with or without submissions.

2. Assessment

The assessment will address:

- i. effects on the environment of allowing the modification or requirement;
- ii. mitigation measures proposed by requiring authority including any proposed conditions:
- iii. other section 171 matters or section 168A(3) (if the requiring authority is Auckland Council) matters where relevant;
- iv. whether land is owned by the requiring authority.

See section 9 of this report for the assessment of each modification and requirement.

On the basis of the assessment, the report concludes that the following modifications/requirements should be modified as recommended in the section 9 assessment checklist.

9. Assessment of modifications and submissions

The Minister of Education requested that the over 400 education facilities with existing designations included in the operative plan which have not lapsed be included in the Proposed Auckland Unitary Plan.

The Minister seeks that the designations be included in the Proposed Auckland Unitary Plan in a standardised form that includes consistent designation descriptions and terms/conditions.

The report considers the list of designations with modifications that are requested to adopt the standard set of conditions provided for in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to the Notice of Requirement by the Minister of Education regarding the inclusion of existing designations in the Auckland Unitary Plan (the Minister's notice of requirement), for which the requiring authority (Minister of Education) and Auckland Council have lodged submissions to correct or modify some provisions.

This is the second of three reports prepared to consider the Minister's designations.

	The requiring authority provided a substantial spreadsheet tabulating all information for every school designation in the region. This was appended to the authority's Memorandum to the Panel dated 17 July 2015. That document is not appended given its bulk.
	Documentation dealing with minor alterations and corrections to boundaries was lodged in August 2012; referenced by the requiring authority as 'Schedule 4 Designation Plans'.
	Annexure 1 includes the relief requested in submissions shown in red text.
Engagement by requiring authority with report writer	There have been extensive discussions to establish an efficient, robust and considered framework for the assessment and reporting on these designations.
Assessment and reasons: modifications	The assessment of the modifications and reasons for the recommendations are the same as those set out in section 9 of the first of the three reports on modifications to the Minister's designations.
Assessment and reasons: submissions - purpose statements	The submissions are for existing designated sites. The change to the purpose statement in each case is to address errors made in the 'rollover' notices and or their incorporation into the Proposed Auckland Unitary Plan. The modifications narrow or make specific the nature of the educational services provided at all designated school sites. These changes are assessed as administrative changes and will not result in any substantive changes to, or environmental effects arising from, these sites. These changes are recorded in Annexure 1. The changes to text are recorded under the header "Description of Modification".
Assessment and reasons: submissions – schedules of conditions	Designation 4639: Ranui Campus: (AC 5716) submitted to delete reference to condition11 as follows:

	These are administrative matters to address a correction and so the modifications are accepted.
	These changes are referenced in Attachment 1.
Assessment and reasons: submissions – plan maps and locations details in text	The modifications, record corrections to plan maps and can be regarded as administrative changes only. There are no changes to the environmental effects resulting from the operation of each educational facility.
	This is an administrative matter to address a correction and so the modification is accepted.
	However, the requiring authority needs to provide marked up maps for the Panel's consideration.
	These changes are provided in map form in Attachment 2.

	These changes are referenced in Attachment 1.
Response from requiring authority	Agrees with the above recommendations to Panel (in letter from Ellis Gould 11 September 2015) except for the following omissions:
	Designation 4628: Massey Primary School Submission 884-61 sought amendment to reflect the specific education purposes on the site. Amended wording to read (with additions in underlining): Education Purposes – primary school (years 0-8) and may include Early Childhood Education (pre-school).
	The Ellis Gould memorandum also noted that the following recommendations were not accepted:
	Designation 5000 –Te Matauranga; Designation 5007 – Willowbank Primary School; Designation 5022 Mansell Senior School; Designation 5044 – Pukekohe Intermediate School; Designation 5027 – Rosehill College.
	In each case the Auckland Council has submitted (5716-minor amendment) seeking to amend the designation purpose statement to which the requiring authority is opposed as the proposed amendments are inconsistent with the current operation of each educational facility.
	No further information has been received from the submitter to clarify these requested amendments. On this basis, and consistent with the requiring authority's view, there is no reason to amend the purpose statements for these designations in the Proposed Auckland Plan.
Report writer's comments	The report writer acknowledges this omission regarding Massey Primary School.
	It is therefore recommended that the recommendations in this report also apply to Designation 4628: Massey Primary School.
	The report writer does not consider there is sufficient evidence to amend the purpose statements for the following designations: Designation 5000 –Te Matauranga;

Designation 5007 – Willowbank Primary School; Designation 5022 Mansell Senior School; Designation 5044 – Pukekohe Intermediate School; Designation 5027 - Rosehill College. It is therefore recommended the purpose statements for these designations remain as set out in the Proposed Auckland Unitary Plan. The recommendation above is reaffirmed for: Designation 4628: Massey Primary School; Designation 4639: Ranui Campus; and Designation 4502: Albany Senior High School. Auckland Council (AC 5716) lodged a number of submission Report writer's final comments points that are recorded in the right -hand column of the spreadsheet in the original submission. The nature of these changes is described as 'minor amendments' and was intended to capture clause 16, Schedule 1 RMA minor amendments, and is a point made by Mr Bain Cross in his statement of evidence (Part B, paragraph 10) dated 5 November 2015 on behalf of Auckland Council. Ms. Orchid Atimalala discusses the reasons for the Ministry of Education not accepting these submission points in her statement of evidence dated 21 October 2015 at paragraphs 10.11-10.16. Auckland Council confirms that it no longer wishes to pursue its submission points to Designations 5000, 5007, 5022, 5044 and 5027. The evidence of Mr Cross (5 November 2015) also confirms that the Auckland Council will not be pursuing any amendments in the list that requiring authorities oppose (again in paragraph 10.3) and specific reference is made to the Ministry of Education in this regard. Finally, legal submissions for the Minister (30 November 2015) confirms that there are no outstanding matters apart from the provision of the mapping corrections to the relevant designations referenced above. These are provided in Attachment 2 below. It is recommended that the Panel recommend the following changes to the Proposed Auckland Unitary Plan: 1. The changes recorded in Attachment 1 concerning the purpose statements to the designations; 2. The changes to the schedule of conditions recorded in Attachment 1; and 3. 





















MoE 18 - Avondale College Minister of Education (Blue hatching indicates addition)










MoE 104 - Glendowie College Minister of Education (Blue hatching indicates addition)






MoE 200 - Mt Eden Normal School Minister of Education (Red hatching indicates removal)










MoE 221 - Oranga School Minister of Education (Blue hatching indicates addition)





MoE 224 - Orewa North Primary School Minister of Education (Blue hatching indicates addition)












