## New Carpark opening

### Opening date for new carpark

We are very pleased to let you all know that the final touches are being made to the new Rawene carpark. We are opening the carpark up for use during the Birkenhead Heritage Festival which will delay us fully completing the carpark for the duration of the festival, however we plan to finish the carpark shortly after i.e. late October.

Please be aware of traffic and pedestrians at all times – especially as everybody is getting used to the new carpark and layout.. We do expect that this area will quickly become busy, so please be considerate.

There will eventually be 124 spaces in the new carpark including 4 disabled spaces. The parking restriction timings are being finalised currently and AT will be monitoring parking times once the car park is formally open.

Here is the latest image from our webcam showing the new tarmac surface, line marking is programmed for tomorrow. Stairs from the new (lower) carpark will be eventually located in the bottom right corner of this photo.

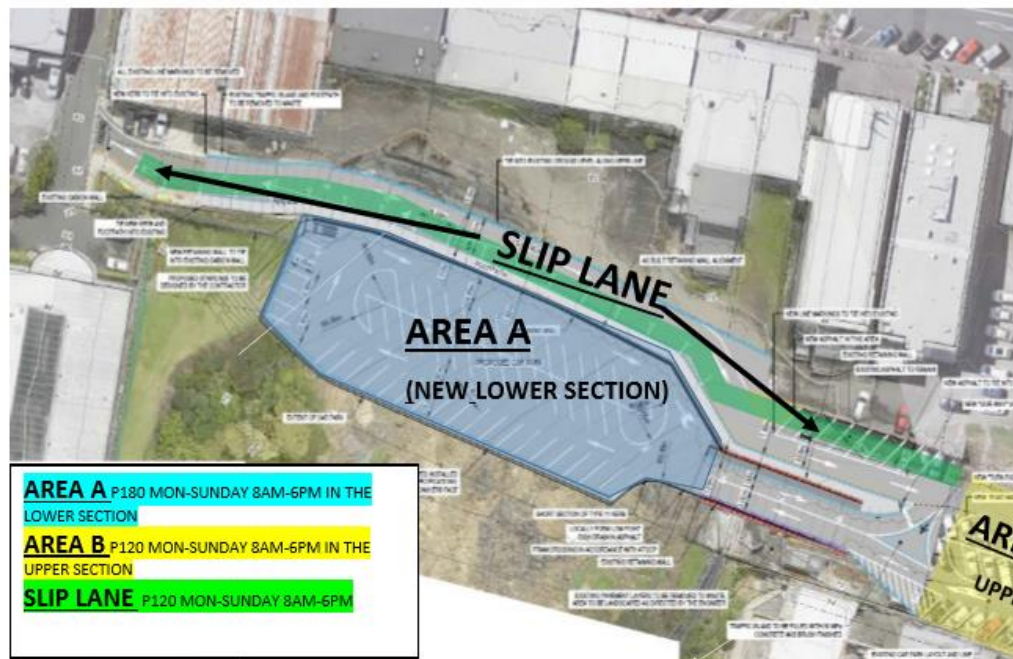
Carpark opening

## Opening date for new carpark

Things are still on track for the new carpark to be opened by the end of October.

We can now confirm that the parking restriction times have been finalised by Auckland Transport (AT). AT will be monitoring parking times once the car park is formally open and will make any changes if required.

Here is a map of the carpark and the parking restrictions that will be in place effective as soon as the carpark is open:

Please be aware of traffic and pedestrians at all times – especially as everybody is getting used to the new carpark and layout. We do expect that this area will quickly become busy, so please be careful and considerate.

<b>Stairs from new carpark</b>	<p>We've mentioned that there will be a set of stairs connecting the new carpark with the slip lane behind the shops at the western end of the site. There have been some further delays with installing these stairs – but we have decided not to delay opening the carpark because of this. The stairs will still be installed, as planned, but not in time for the carpark opening. They will be completed soon after the carpark is open.</p> <p>In the meantime, the ramp will need to be used as a pedestrian accessway if you park in the new carpark. Please be aware of cars if you are walking, and pedestrians if you are driving!</p>
<b>Construction on site</b>	<p>As mentioned above, things are still new and there needs to be a certain amount of care and consideration for other users in cars and on foot. The land below the new carpark, down into the gully, is still a construction site. Activity on site in this area will continue (tidying) and there will be no public access beyond the boundary of the new carpark.</p>
